



**Dear Member,**

Due to recent regulatory changes issued from the Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health, the Alberta provincial government has mandated that the **enhanced vaccine certificate with QR code** must now be shown for entry into all businesses that require proof of vaccination. Other vaccine receipts will no longer be accepted as a form of proof of vaccination.

**WHAT THIS MEANS FOR OUR MEMBERS:**

In order to comply with this government regulation, all members will be required to revalidate their vaccination status through display of their enhanced vaccine certificate with QR code (either digitally on their mobile device or as a physical copy of the QR code) along with government issued photo ID. This is a one-time process\* and once you have revalidated your vaccination status, you will be able to re-enter the club freely without further delay in relation to all future visits.

For our member's convenience, an **Express Service** table has been set up within the club lobby where MOVATI team members will be on hand to process your proof of enhanced vaccine certificate with QR code and help get you to your workout quickly.

If you do not yet have your enhanced vaccine certificate with QR code, regrettably you will not be allowed entry. You can download your enhanced vaccine certificate with QR code [here](#).

We understand that these ongoing changes to regulations are frustrating and inconvenient, but we must continue to support all legislated efforts designed to keep our members and employees safe and our Club open.
